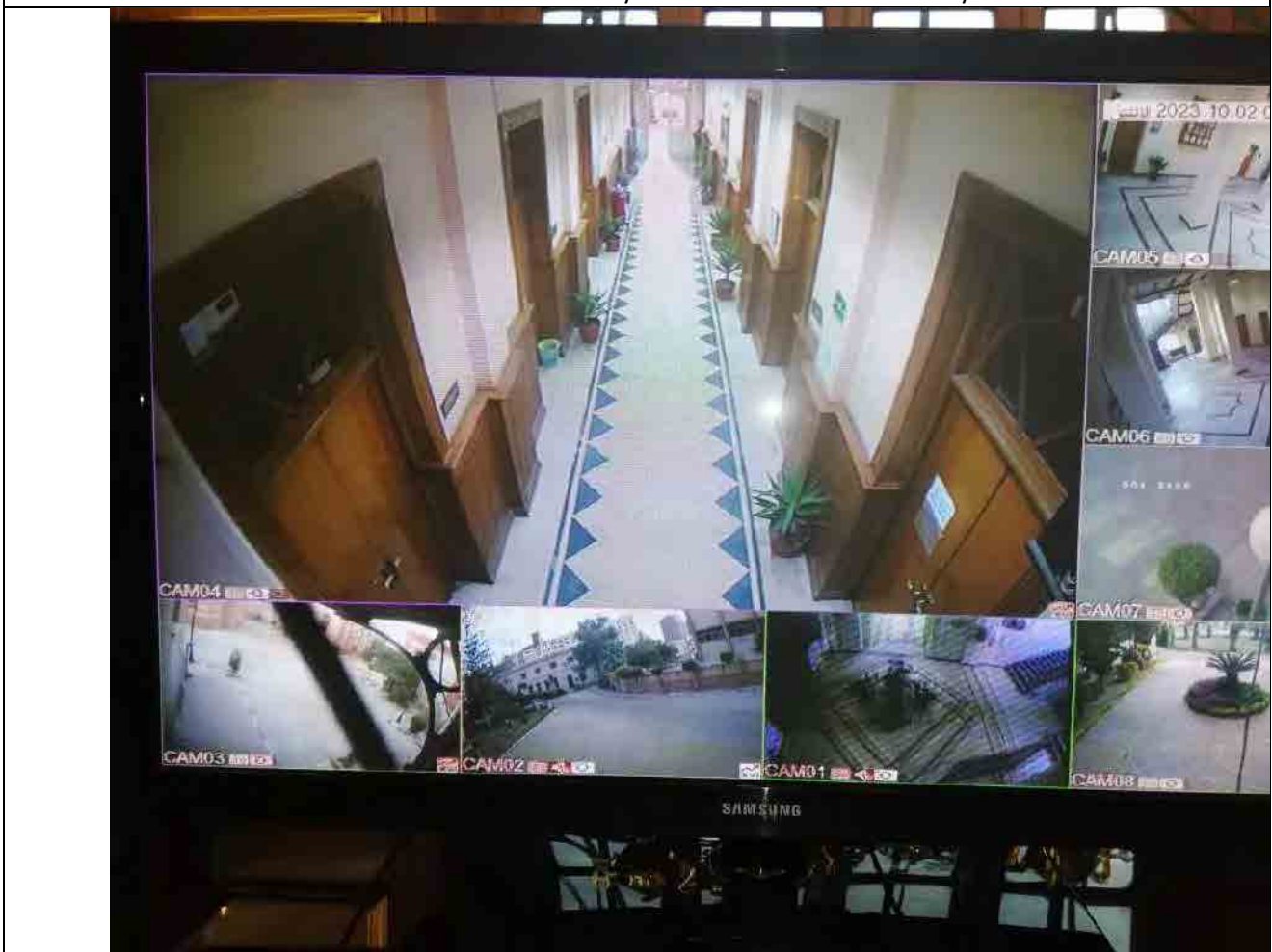

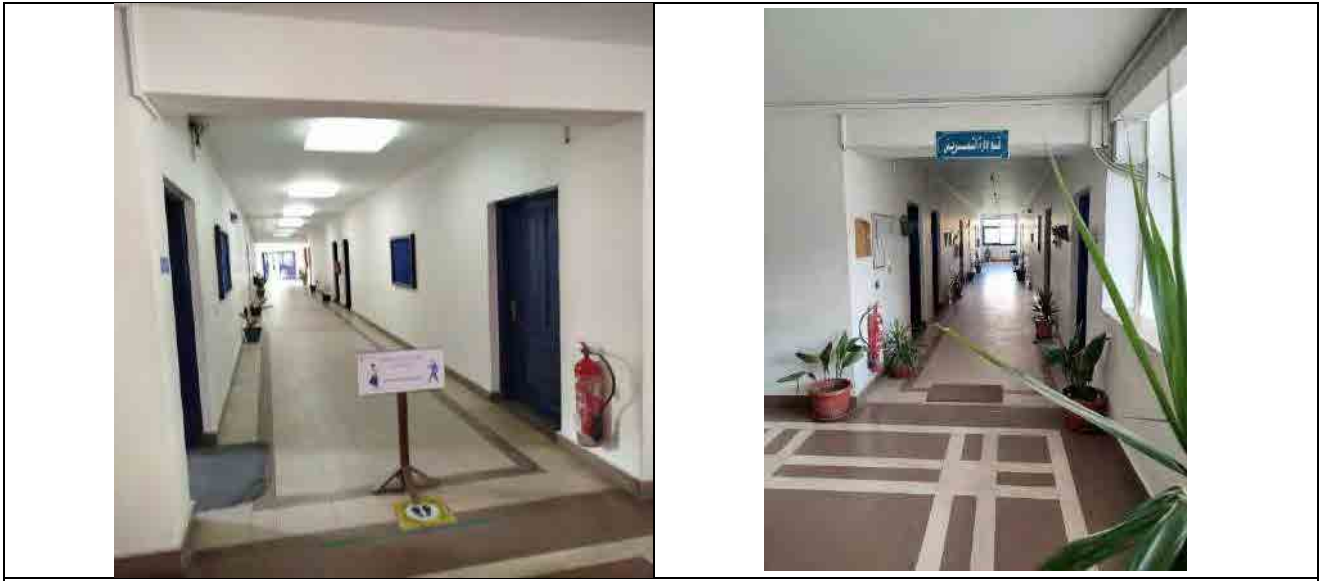

#### Description:

1. Fire distinguisher and sand buckets (Alexandria University).
2. Fire Exit (Alexandria University): There is an emergency exits in all faculty buildings with fire exit plan
3. Security Doors for the Exam control rooms (Alexandria University).
4. Fire alarm call point
5. Fire Alarm (smoke detector)
6. Fire distinguisher and description of how to use it properly (Alexandria University)
7. Video surveillance systems are deployed at various locations within a university campus to enhance security, safety, and operational efficiency. Video surveillance systems are used to monitor the outside perimeter and entrance of all University buildings.
8. Each Faculty at Alexandria University has a student team for occupational safety and health. The student attend several workshops during the academic year. Workshops, seminars, and awareness campaigns educate the students about safety and health issues, including fire safety and personal safety. The student teams play a crucial role in promoting and maintaining a safe and healthy environment.
9. The student team conduct regular safety inspections of campus facilities and report any safety hazards to the university administration for prompt rectification.

#### Fire extinguishing systems in faculties and institutes of the university

**Hospitals:** The firefighting system is currently being changed from the manual system to the automatic fire network system. For example, in Smouha University and the main university hospital (Automatic sprinkler system "Water" FM 200).

**Universities:** All Universities are still operating with the manual extinguishing system:

- 1- 45 inch water networks and 3 inch water networks.
- 2- Mobile extinguishers system
  - a) CO<sub>2</sub> Extinguishers
  - b) Powder extinguishers
- 3- There is an emergency exits in all faculty buildings with fire exit plan.



All devices are subject to annual maintenance. The attached pdf is an example of Minutes of the Occupational Safety and Health Committee meeting, which is held every three months. The Committee make a yearly plan. In the meeting they discuss their activity program and regularly discuss any problems observed during this period.

#### **Aim of the Program**

- To complement the role of the Safety Unit at the Faculty of Science in raising awareness of the concept of occupational safety and health.
- To apply the requirements of occupational safety and health in the Faculty of Science in all its buildings and departments.
- To achieve the practical application of the students for the occupational safety and health course 040306225 which has become a course that meets the needs of the labor market for our country's promising youth.
- To complement the unit's summer activity, which began in spring 2021.

#### **Eligibility for joining the team:**

The student must have completed the study of the occupational safety and health course (040306225).

#### **Program Subject:**

#### **The program includes Five main activities:**

- 1- **Lectures** from specialists in the field of occupational safety and health.
- 2- **Workshops** that serve the field of occupational safety and health such as first aid and fire fighting....etc.
- 3- **Field visits** to different and diverse companies to learn how to apply occupational safety and health requirements in various installations.
- 4- **Field training in the faculty**

The training is carried out under the supervision of a coordinator from each department of the faculty. It includes how to apply occupational safety and health requirements in the faculty and its various departments to avoid various work risks, by applying different activities. For example: arrangement, organization and indexing of chemicals (soft and hard copies) in the various laboratories of the faculty.

Preparation of the material safety data sheet of Hazardous Chemicals (MSDS).

- An inventory of occupational safety and health equipment located in the different departments of the faculty (fire extinguishers of all kinds, sand buckets, first aid boxes, emergency signs... etc).

### 5- E-Activity

The electronic activities include performing the following topics:

- ❖ Preparing a guide for the application of safety requirements with the use of local and international references.
- ❖ How to prepare an emergency, evacuation and working group plan.
- ❖ How to dispose of waste and its types - mechanisms used (references).
- ❖ How to prevent and respond to fires (different causes).
- ❖ Designing an opinion poll on the extent of awareness of the general requirements for safety among college students with its circulation and analysis.
- ❖ Safety guidelines in laboratories (during experiments and after completion) according to disciplines - chemistry - physics - computer - geology and biology.
- ❖ Preparation and design of awareness videos ((Infograph).

## Statement of Activities of the Safety and Health Committee from July 2023 to October 2024

- 1. Training of Committee Members at the Labor Cultural Institution:** A total of seven committee members received basic safety and health training at the Labor Cultural Institution from September 17 to September 28, 2023, and obtained their training certificates.
- 2. Fire Extinguisher Maintenance:** The condition of fire extinguishers was monitored, and they were refilled and serviced annually. Maintenance was carried out in August 2023 and September 2024.
- 3. First Aid Kit Inventory:** The contents of first aid kits, including medical supplies and medications, were replenished in all college buildings and departments at the beginning of the academic year, specifically from October 2023 to February 2024 (follow-up) and again in October 2024. The committee assigned the safety officer at the Moharram Bey building to report biweekly on the usage of first aid kit contents.
- 4. Chemical Inventory Management:** The safety of chemicals was monitored, and a special location was prepared for storing expired chemicals and fluorescent bulbs until their safe disposal by the Nazaria landfill on August 29, 2023.
- 5. Building Roof Monitoring:** The condition of building roofs regarding rainwater drainage was monitored by building supervisors and safety officials before the onset of winter in September 2023 and September 2024.
- 6. Compliance During Restoration:** Compliance with safety and health regulations was ensured during restoration work at the college building in Shatby.
- 7. Elevator Monitoring:** The status of elevators was checked, with maintenance performed on December 5, 2023. Monitoring continued during restoration work in Shatby. The Safety and Health Committee decided on October 2, 2024, to suspend the use of elevators in Buildings A and B until their maintenance was completed, starting from October 2, 2024.
- 8. Water Tank Cleaning:** Regular cleaning and disinfection of water tanks were carried out.
- 9. Biannual Statistics:** Biannual statistics were compiled for the periods from June 30, 2023, to December 31, 2023, and from January 1, 2024, to June 30, 2024.
- 10. Fire Extinguisher Training:** Laboratory technicians, storekeepers, and supporting service workers were trained on the use of fire extinguishers on April 30, 2024, at the college playground in Moharram Bey.
- 11. Emergency Evacuation Training:** A training session on safe evacuation in emergencies was organized for firefighting and evacuation teams on May 9, 2024.
- 12. Firefighting Training:** Five committee members received fire prevention training from the Alexandria Civil Defense at the university city.
- 13. Attendance at Workshops:** Two committee members attended workshops on:
  - o Mental Health on April 23, 2024.
  - o Crisis Management and Problem-Solving on April 24, 2024. This was part of a skills development program organized by the African Center for Women's Health Services in Alexandria.
- 14. Safety Compliance Monitoring:** Safety and health regulations were monitored and enforced in the college workshops and storage facilities in Moharram Bey.



15. **Emergency Plan Approval:** The emergency plan for college buildings (Shatby, Moharram Bey, Marine Sciences) was approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Office of the Ministry of Manpower in April 2024.
16. **Waste Disposal Contracting:** Procedures are being undertaken to contract with Nahdet Misr for the safe disposal of solid waste. The Safety and Health Committee recommended in its meeting on December 6, 2023, the inclusion of a clause for the safe disposal of biological waste.
17. **Student Safety and Health Team Program Report:** A report was prepared on the student safety and health team program at the Faculty of Science, which was conducted between July 13, 2023, and August 31, 2023.

The program includes four main components:

1. **Lectures by specialized professors** in the field of occupational safety and health.
2. **Workshops** serving the field of occupational safety and health, covering topics like first aid and fire prevention, among others.
3. **Field visits** to various companies to learn how to implement safety and health regulations in different establishments.
4. **Field training** at the college, which includes applying safety and health regulations within the college and its various departments to mitigate different workplace hazards.

Additionally, students in the field training program are divided into different departments of the college, each supervised by a coordinator and a group of students.

A new student team for safety and health initiatives has been established for the year 2024. They were trained through the occupational safety and health training program from July 7, 2024, to July 31, 2024. This program included a series of lectures, workshops in occupational safety and health, field training, and company visits to learn about implementing safety and health regulations in these establishments.

### **Field training at the Faculty of Science**

This training includes how to implement safety and health regulations in the college and its various departments to mitigate different work hazards. Field training students were divided into workgroups in various departments of the Moharram Bey building under the supervision of a coordinator from each department.

A new student team for safety and health at the Faculty was formed for the year 2024. They were trained through the safety and health training program from July 7, 2024, to July 31, 2024. This program includes a series of lectures and workshops in the field of safety and health, as

well as field training and company visits to learn how to apply safety and health regulations in these establishments.

Safety regulations were monitored within the plant storage, and a committee was formed to transfer the old equipment located in the storage related to the Chemistry Department.

Maintenance and refilling of fire extinguishers (in various types) for the college buildings (Moharram Bey Building, Shatby Building, Marine Sciences Building, and Cockcroft Building) were completed, and the extinguishers were distributed to the departments.

The air conditioning units in lecture halls (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 9) in the Moharram Bey Building have been serviced. The second phase involved servicing the air conditioning units in lecture halls (2, Zewail, and the Clinic) in the Shatby Building. One of the committee members was also tasked with overseeing the replacement of all broken glass in all windows of the Moharram Bey Building.







Corrective actions that have been taken over the academic year 2023/2024 include:

### Safety Preparations and Infrastructure

1. Regular Maintenance of Fire Extinguishers: Ensuring that all fire extinguishers are routinely checked and serviced to remain operational and effective.
2. Installation of Fire Extinguishers in Research Laboratories: Adding additional fire extinguishers to critical areas, such as research labs, to enhance safety measures.
3. Training Relevant Personnel on Fire Extinguisher Use: Conducting training sessions for staff and students on the proper use of fire extinguishers to ensure they are prepared to respond effectively in emergencies.
4. Developing Monitoring Forms for Departments and Administration: Creating templates to monitor compliance with safety regulations across various departments and administrative units.
5. Establishment of Student Teams for Safety Training: Forming student groups focused on training and implementing safety protocols within the college.
6. Conducting Training Workshops for Technicians and Workers: Organizing workshops to enhance the safety skills of technical staff and laborers, ensuring they are equipped to handle potential hazards in their work environments.
