Admisions



- 1 Applicants for this program should meet existing Egyptian National Entry requirements to study Dentistry at the University of Alexandria by bringing the nomination card (TANSIK) obtained from the Ministry of Higher Education stating that he/she has been accepted into one of the dental colleges in Egypt.
- 2 Potential candidates for the program will be interviewed using the University of Manchester's existing methods and interviews will take place at Alexandria Faculty of Dentistry, successful students will be selected jointly by both universities.
- The online application and admission process for this joint program will be detailed on Alexandria Faculty of Dentistry UoM/UoA joint degree website.
- 4 The English Language requirements are mandatory for students in this program and set out as follows:
 - National high school students should have a minimum score of 6.5 overall with 6.5 of IELTS in each component.
 - IGCSE Students will be required to have O-Level English at Grade B or above.
 - American Diploma students with SAT/ACT should achieve result B (with English and Math offered in Year 12) is a must.

Original Documents must be submitted stamped and legalized in English language to the administration office during the admission period and must fulfill the financial requirements to be considered an accepted student.

Academic rules



- The program follows the credit hours system, A student is required to finish 181 credit hours on average in ten semesters / five years in order to graduate.
- 2 The academic year has two main semesters; fall and spring, each consisting of 15 weeks.
- 3 A student can register an average of 16-18 credits per semester.

Graduation



The official graduation ceremony will be held at Alexandria University with representatives from the University of Manchester present. Students who complete the program will also be entitled to attend a graduation ceremony at the University of Manchester and this will be at their own expense.
